FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ,

“Who is able to comprehend the mystery of the Trinity for height and depth are filled by Him and is not subject to inquiry? The Father begot the Only-Begotten, the First-Born Son became man, and the Holy Spirit is the Paraclete, the Perfecter and Completer. Glory be to the Hidden One who is uncontainable in His nature – Three Adorable Persons, One Lordship glorified by creation.”

-From the Syriac Maronite Rite of Kneeling for the Feast of Pentecost

The Feast of the Holy Trinity comes to us from the Latin Church and its liturgical cycle. The opening hymn for today’s liturgy is taken from the first watch of the traditional Rite of Kneeling from the Feast of Pentecost. The hymnodist asks, “Who is able to comprehend the mystery of the Trinity?” and notes that “height and depth” are filled by God’s Presence – meaning that all of Creation is filled with God but is not able to contain Him. The hymnodist also states that the Mystery of the Trinity is “not subject to inquiry.” We, as finite creatures, are unable to plunge into the depths of the immense mystery of the Godhead and even if we were to try, we would never be able to fully understand. He goes on to write, “Glory be to the Hidden One who is uncontainable in His nature...” showing us that God cannot be contained – by Heaven, by Earth, or by our intellect. We can only glorify the Mystery of the Trinity and praise the Hidden One through the names that He has revealed to us – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Apostles' Fast. The Ancient Apostles' Fast before the Feast of Sts. Peter and Paul begins on Friday, 10 June until 28 June. The obligatory days of the Apostles' Fast as decreed by the Synod of Mount Lebanon (1736) are 25-28 June. The usual fasting practices are observed.

Second Collection. A second collection will be taken on Sunday, 26 June for the Holy Father's Collection (Peter's Pence).
