# PARISH EVENTS AND POINTS OF INTEREST

**Welcome!** We wish a warm welcome to all our visitors and to those who already call St. George home. We are happy to have you worshipping with us. Please feel free to introduce yourself to the parish clergy. We hope you will soon make St. George your spiritual home!

**Feast of the Annunciation.** We will celebrate **Evening Prayer and Liturgy for the Feast of the Annunciation on Thursday, 24 March at 6:00pm.** Liturgy for the feast day will be celebrated at 8:30am on **Friday, 25 March.** The Annunciation is not a day of fast.

**Open Liturgy Intentions.** A binder has been placed in the narthex with open liturgy intention dates for the next few months. Liturgies can be offered for the departed, for the living, for special intentions (kept private), for wider intentions on behalf of others or the world, etc. Please avail yourselves of this beautiful tradition to offer the Holy Mysteries on the behalf of others.

**Eparchial Charities Appeal** is the annual Bishop's Appeal that funds our **Seminary**, helps our **retired clergy**, and funds many initiatives throughout the Eparchy. For 2022 our parish has been **assessed a goal of \$5,500.** Thank you for your generosity to our Eparchy to further the Work of God in the United States.

**Faith Formation.** Youth Faith Formation will conclude next **Sunday, 27 March** at 9:20am. Our **Adult Faith Formation** program will conclude on **Wednesday, 30 March with Vespers and Class at 6:00pm.**

**Fasting.** As a reminder, fasting in the **Syriac Maronite** tradition consists of abstaining from **all meat, dairy products, and alcohol from Midnight until Noon Monday-Friday of Great Lent.** Meals may be taken in the afternoon but without meat, dairy, or alcohol. Traditionally, fish is also excluded during Great Lent. **Saturdays and Sundays are exempt** from the Lenten Fast.

**Lenten Evening Prayer.** During **Wednesdays and Fridays of Great Lent**, we will pray the Office of **Evening Prayer at 6:00pm.** **Benediction of the Cross** will also be celebrated on **Fridays.**

**Ladies Guild Fish Fry.** Our **Lenten Fish Fry** returns during the **Fridays of Great Lent.** Lunch will be served from **11:00am-2:00pm** and Dinner from **4:00pm-6:00pm.** Preorders are available and **recommended.** More information will be available on our website and Facebook. We are also in need of **volunteers** to help work shifts. Orders can be made online at <https://stgeorgeuniontownladiesguild.square.site> or by calling the parish office.

**Easter Flowers.** Thank you to everyone who memorialized a loved for Christmas through a gift of flowers, the Holy of Holies was beautifully decorated for the feast. 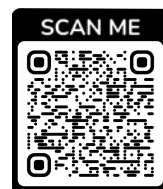

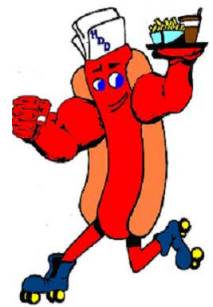
