#### FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ.

During this season of the Holy Cross the Church gives us a time to reflect upon the Second Coming of Christ. Often, the idea of the "End Times" gets associated with certain strands of Evangelical Protestantism or obscure cults that promise that the "end" will be tomorrow because they calculated some mystical mathematical formula from a scriptural or mystic text.

However, this approach to the "end times" is not the approach that we apostolic Christians take. Because we "know not the time nor the hour" of the Lord's Coming, we offer the Liturgy in joyful expectation of the Lord's Day. We celebrate all the Mysteries of the Church to prepare ourselves to be ready to meet the Lord on that awesome Day. We sign ourselves with the Cross of Christ to bear the seal of our King and Master so that He will acknowledge us as His own beloved heirs.

The Cross is our connection to and hope for the Lord's Day. It is the banner of victory that will appear in the Eastern sky at His Coming. It is the Cross that will cause all the powers of Evil to flee in defeat on that Day. But, we may or may not be here when our Lord comes. So, even if we will not be here on that Day, we live our lives in expectation of it and with the joy and hope that comes with being sealed with the Holy Cross from the day of our baptism to the day of our burial.

Let us rejoice in the Cross of Christ, for through it we have been saved and by it Death and Sin are conquered!

## PARISH EVENTS AND POINTS OF INTEREST

Welcome! We wish a warm welcome to all our visitors and to those who already call St. George home. We are happy to have you worshipping with us. Please feel free to introduce yourself to the parish clergy. We hope you will soon make St. George your spiritual home!

Liturgy Intentions. Liturgy Intention scheduling for the new liturgical year can now be done by contacting the Parish Office or in the binder in the narthex. If you would like to schedule a liturgy for a loved one or *any other intention*, please contact the parish office, send a note via mail or collection basket, or email. If you have already scheduled a specific or recurring monthly or yearly liturgy, please remember to send in your stipend before the liturgy is celebrated.

Bible Study. Our Bible Study Program meets twice monthly for Vespers at 6:00pm followed by Bible Study at 6:30pm. The next study will be on the Book of Psalms on 10 October.

**Faith Formation**. All school age children are **expected** to be enrolled and regularly attending Faith Formation, participating in the MYO, serving the Liturgy (for boys), or in other roles during and outside the liturgy (for girls).

Order of St. Sharbel. 8 October is Order of St. Sharbel Sunday where the Eparchy encourages new enrollment in the Order. The Order of St. Sharbel is vitally important in providing spiritual and financial support for our seminarians, who are crucial for the future of our Maronite Church. This year we have three men preparing for the priesthood for our Eparchy. Please prayerfully consider joining the Order. To be eligible for any Parish Scholarships, or to be recommended for any NAM or Eparchial awards, a child must be a regular communicant at Sunday and Festal liturgies and an active participant in the MYO/Faith Formation program.
