FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ,

The *qolo* for this Sunday's Liturgy poses for us a beautiful comparison:

Though Cherubim fear the One who is clothed with fire, a woman takes hold of his cloak and is not burnt. Though fiery ranks tremble in awe before their Lord, this woman who kisses his cloak fears not at all. Praise to the One, whose face angels cannot behold, who, here below, shows no rage when his cloak is touched. All those on earth and in heaven now worship him. From every mouth he created let there be praise!

The hymn writer gives us two opposing images: the angelic hosts who shield themselves from the blazing and dreadful presence of the Throne of God and the boldness of the hemorrhagic woman who reaches out in faith to obtain healing and pardon from Jesus Christ. Also, we are confronted with the image of God whose very presence burns the angels of fire who receives the touch of the woman without showing her any reaction other than mercy.

The hemorrhagic woman is one of the most important models for a Christian – all of us are impure through our sin, yet we are promised that if we reach out to the Lord in repentance, just like the woman from the Gospel, the Door of Mercy will be opened to us. We can approach the blazing fire of God's love and mercy through the Sacraments with boldness, a boldness that the angels themselves do not enjoy. They hide themselves from the presence of God, where we, as Christian believers, boldly become Temples of God's presence through the Sacraments!


