FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ,

The Syriac Churches sing a hymn on Friday night that prays:

Adam instructed his children of what reason he and Eve were called to depart from Paradise. He spoke to them of his former authority and of his fall and his exile when he was shamed. It is not fitting for the foot that ran to the Tree to tread the Holy Place when it is not clean. It is not right for the hand that plucked the fruit in Eden to wave over the Offering of the Lord. Christ, who came and walked on the earth and uprooted its thorns, by you Adam returned to Paradise.

All of us, by birth, are children of Adam. Because of his fall it is not fitting that Adam's children would minister to the Lord in worship. However, because of the Incarnation and because of the Cross, we are not merely children of Adam.

All Christians, by the new birth of Baptism, are children of the Father once again. This is why Christians may again offer prayer, sacrifice, and worship to God. Adam walked through the Garden to the Tree and plucked Its Fruit leading to Death. Christ walked upon the Earth to the Tree and became Himself the Fruit that we pluck in the Eucharist leading to Life. May we walk always with the Lord towards the Tree of Life, and not follow the footsteps of our father Adam in his path of disobedience, exile, and shame. For the Cross is our refuge, our protection, and our joy!
