FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ,

In Christianity and Judaism, both religions with linear views of salvation history (beginning, middle, end), there is still a strong connection to the cycle of Birth, Growth, Decay, Death, and Rebirth that you see in other religious traditions. While we don't believe in past lives or reincarnation, the change of seasons reminds us of the cycles that occur in salvation history (sin, punishment, repentance, atonement, forgiveness.... birth, baptism, repentance, death, resurrection, eternity... etc.). Everywhere we look outside we see the beautiful colors of the changing leaves on the trees. This yearly cycle of the seasons is a manifestation of this pattern of creation, decay, and rebirth.

The Church celebrates the change of agricultural seasons (Our Lady of the Seeds, Our Lady of the Harvest, etc.) and has her own spiritual seasons as well. Next week begins a new liturgical season and a new liturgical year. The Season of Announcements begins with the Sunday of the Consecration the Church. This preamble to the Sundays of of Announcements allows us to renew ourselves at the beginning of the Church Year, to renew the physical temple that is the Church and to renew the temple of our bodies and souls that also forms the Church of Christ. Let us take the time to examine our lives over the past year - what has gone well? What requires change in ourselves? What should our priorities and goals be for the coming year - as individuals and as a parish community?

All Saints. We will celebrate Liturgy for the feast of All Saints on Wednesday, 1 November at 7:00pm. This is a Holy Day of Obligation.

Toys for Tots. The Uniontown Fire Department is collecting donations (monetary or toys) for this year's Toys for Tots. Donations can be brought to the Parish Office or to the Fire Department.

**Collection Counters and Lectors.** We are in need of volunteers for **collection counters** and Old Testament **Lectors** beginning in the New Year. Willing and interested parties are asked to contact the Parish Office.

Altar & Rosary Society Memorial. ARS will celebrate its annual Memorial Liturgy on Sunday, 12 November at the 10:30am Liturgy. ARS will pray the Rosary and recite the Litany to the Mother of God at 9:45am. All members are invited to join in the Parish Hall for refreshments following the Liturgy.

**Faith Formation**. All school age children are **expected** to be enrolled and regularly attending Faith Formation, participating in the MYO, serving the Liturgy (for boys), or in other roles during and outside the liturgy (for girls).

To be eligible for any Parish Scholarships, or to be recommended for any NAM or Eparchial awards, a child must be a regular communicant at Sunday and Festal liturgies and an active participant in the MYO/Faith Formation program.
