Dear Friends in Christ,

## Christ is Risen! Truly He is Risen!

The Sedro for Easter has a beautiful comparison between Friday and Sunday: "On Friday the King endured pain and was crucified, and today victory has been achieved by His Resurrection! On Friday a lance pierced His side, and today in His compassion the waters of Baptism flow! On Friday He was crowned with thorns, and today He has adorned his Church with a crown of splendor!"

This refers to the historical events of Good Friday and Easter and to the ongoing "spiritual" Fridays and Sundays that each of us experience throughout our lives. We all experience moments of trial, defeat, and despair and moments of triumph, victory, and joy. This is true of us as a Church, as a parish, and as individuals. It is because of the promise of the Resurrection that we can find hope and joy amid moments of despair and trial. Christ has fought the fight and won the victory so we might be able to overcome our own trials and tribulations. He took on all that we have so we might take on what He has – eternal life.


