#### FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ,

One of the verses of the *mazmooro* for this feast prays:

The barren Elizabeth greets Mary, the daughter of David, the Mother of our Lord: Come in peace, for the Child in your womb is the Creator of the world and its inhabitants.

Today we commemorate the visitation of Mary and Elizabeth and the visitation of Jesus to his herald, John the Baptist. This great meeting – between the Virgin and the Barren One, between the Word, and His Voice, is a marvel for us to ponder. In the hills of Judea, the Creator of the cosmos goes on a trip to meet the Forerunner, and the Mother of God, Mother and Virgin, goes to meet her cousin, the righteous Elizabeth, the Barren One with child.

## PARISH EVENTS AND POINTS OF INTEREST

Welcome! We wish a warm welcome to all our visitors and to those who already call St. George home. We are happy to have you worshipping with us. Please feel free to introduce yourself to the parish clergy. We hope you will soon make St. George your spiritual home!

Christmas Flowers. Donations may be made In Memory or In Honor of your family members and friends. Please use the flower offering envelope or the form that is inserted in the bulletin. You may place them in the collection or send them to the parish office no later than 19 December.

ARS-LG Christmas Party. Ladies attending the Altar & Rosary-Ladies Guild Christmas Party on 3 December are asked to bring men's socks for St. Vincent DePaul. Each pack of socks will receive a ticket to win a door prize. Bring as many as you like!

St. Barbara. In honor of the Feast of St. Barbara, youth in our MCF program are invited and encouraged to dress as saints (or bring another appropriate Halloween Costume out of storage) on Sunday, 3 December. St. Barbara treats will be available for the Children on this day!

Nativity Fast. The traditional Nativity Fast would begin this year on Wednesday, 15 November and you are encouraged to keep the ancient fast. The Nativity Fast prescribed for our Eparchy begins on Saturday, 16 December and continues through to Christmas Eve. The typical fasting proscriptions are to be observed.

Toys for Tots. The Uniontown Fire Department is collecting donations (monetary or toys) for this year's Toys for Tots. Donations can be brought to the Parish Office or to the Fire Department.

**Collection Counters and Lectors.** We are in need of volunteers for **collection counters** and Old Testament **Lectors** beginning in the New Year. Willing and interested parties are asked to contact the Parish Office.

Bulletin Advertising. If you wish to continue (or add an advertisement) in the Bulletin the yearly cost is \$250. Thank you to all who have advertised and patronized our businesses. This helps to defray the printing costs of the bulletin each year.

**Liturgy Intentions.** Liturgy Intention scheduling for the new liturgical year can now be done by contacting the Parish Office or in the binder in the narthex. If you would like to schedule a liturgy for a loved one or *any other intention*, please **contact the parish office**, send a note via **mail** or **collection basket**, or **email**. If you have already scheduled a specific or recurring monthly or yearly liturgy, please remember to send in your stipend **before** the liturgy is celebrated.

Bible Study. Our Bible Study Program meets twice monthly for Vespers at 6:00pm followed by Bible Study at 6:30pm. The current study covers the Book of Psalms.

Faith Formation. All school age children are expected to be enrolled and regularly attending Faith Formation, participating in the MYO, serving the Liturgy (for boys), or in other roles during and outside the liturgy (for girls).

Maronite Youth Organization. All youth in Grades 6-12 are encouraged to sign up for MYO. Please call or text Subdeacon Chuck Michael at 724.323.4653. Also, please sign up on Remind to keep up to date with any MYO events and announcements by texting @myo202 to 81010. To be eligible for any Parish Scholarships, or to be recommended for any NAM or Eparchial awards, a child must be a regular communicant at Sunday and Festal liturgies and an active participant in the MYO/Faith Formation program.
