FROM THE DESK OF THE PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ,

One of the hymns of the Divine Office for the Feast of the Consecration of the Church prays,

"Blest is Christ Who wed you, O Church, by His crucifixion and established in you the Holy Altar for the forgiveness of debts. In you He broke His Body and mixed His Blood, and He placed them before you that you should eat, drink, delight and glorify Him."

We will see in the hymns and prayers of this feast a strong emphasis on the altar of the Church and on the Eucharistic sacrifice of Christ's Body and Blood. This is what sets the Church, as a body of believers and as a physical building, apart from others. Any group can get together to sing songs and listen to readings. Any building can be built to house people for a common purpose. But what sets the Church apart is the Eucharist.

The Offering of the Body and Blood of the Lord in liturgical worship is what sets us apart from others. This is how the Church, and we, are sanctified, consecrated, and renewed throughout our lives.

The Eucharist exists so that we might "eat, drink, delight, and glorify Him." We are sustained physically, we take delight in the beauty of the worship of the Lord, and we offer glory to Him for all the gifts that He has bestowed on us through the power of the Church and Her reconciling Altar.

To be eligible for any Parish Scholarships, or to be recommended for any NAM or Eparchial awards, a child must be a regular communicant at Sunday and Festal liturgies and an active participant in the MYO/Faith Formation program.
